# **Driver Education Program**

Obtaining a driver's license creates a sense of independence, freedom and security.

One aspect is acquiring employment which often relies on having a driver's license rather than being dependent on public transport.

We have been running the Driver Education Program for more than 10 years north of the river. This year we have expanded the program south of the river into Cannington in partnership with Communicare, who contributed to support an additional 18 clients into the program.



After a profile raising campaign extra funding was received and this allowed us to reduce the waiting list in the Northern corridor. We were particularly grateful for the additional funding from the Department of Home Affairs and local donors.


